



Prevent COVID-19: Clinic Screening Procedures

ALL clients will need to

- Wear a Mask, if they do not have one then one can be provided to them
- Submit to a temperature check, should the temperature be 100 or higher they will be asked to sit for a few mins and take a second temperature. Temperatures of 103 and higher will be asked to leave.
- Clients will be asked to use hand sanitizer before going into a therapy session

If a client refuses to submit to any of the required procedures above, they will be asked to leave the building. These procedures are a requirement to have in person services at this time.

The following screener questions will then be completed:

1. Ask the individual if they have any of the following respiratory symptoms?
 - Fever
 - Sore throat
 - Cough
 - Any new onset of shortness of breath

If YES to any of the symptoms, ask them to leave the building. They may or may not have COVID-19, and the potential consequences to COVID-19 entering the building is serious enough to ask them to not continue with services for the day even though they may not have it. Many populations outside of the elderly do not show any symptoms but are able to transmit the virus to others.

If NO to all proceed to question #2.

2. Ask the individual if they have:
 - Travelled internationally within the last 14 days to areas where COVID-19 cases have been confirmed.
 - Worked in another health care setting that has confirmed COVID-19 cases
 - Been exposed to COVID-19 or are awaiting any pending COVID-19 test results

If YES to any, ask them to not enter the building.
